



South Australia - Emigration

The Colonization Commissioners we understand have communicated their intention of dispatching another ship very shortly, and have fixed a day for approving of a limited number of free emigrants from this neighbourhood. The regulations established apply to healthy married persons not exceeding 30 years of age, but admit of an exception in favour of respectable parents above that age, who have a large family of children, with at least an equal proportion of girls. The plan adopted is, to convey parties from the same county as much as possible together, and some considerable time may elapse before another turn can be given to those from Wiltshire
