



Great Western Railway Agreement

An arrangement has been made with Mr. Brunel for his past and future services, on the following terms, viz.:-

To close existing claims and to settle all accounts to this time, £5,000. Remuneration for all professional services to the Company, for 1850, £3,500; for 1851, £3,000; and for 1852, £2,000. In addition to these sums, Mr. Brunel is to be allowed for office and all other expenses, for 1850, £2,500; for 1851, £2,000; and for 1852, £1,000. The Committee strongly recommend the engaging of a solicitor, to devote the whole of his time to the services of the Company, upon an annual salary, and that the Company's records and title deeds should be deposited in safe custody on the Company's premises; by which a large saving, as well as security, will be effected.
