



Election of Officers for Poor Law Union

The parishes of Bradford, Westwood, Monkton Farley, Broughton Gifford, Great Chalfield, Little Chalfield with Cottles, and Wingfield with Rowley, in Wilts. and Freshford in Somerset, now form a union or district for the administration, by guardians elected by the ratepayers, of the laws for the relief of the poor.

The following are the newly elected officers of the union:- Mr. William Timbrell, clerk; Mr. Thomas Hopkins, treasurer; Messrs. Adye, medical attendants; Mr. Merrick, sen, auditor of accounts; Messrs. James Baker, John Huntley and John Forster, relieving overseers.
