

Winsley's War Graves



In the peaceful churchyard of St. Nicholas, Winsley are three WWII war graves, two of which commemorate British casualties and one which commemorates a Polish serviceman.

| Surname | Given Names | Rank | Service | Date of Death |
|------------|------------------|-------------------------|---------------|-------------------|
| Godkin | Gladys E | Aircraftwoman 2nd Class | W.A.A.F | 18th October 1942 |
| Pocock | Norman Llewellyn | Corporal | R.A.A.F | 5th June 1945 |
| Mietlinski | Stanislav | Marine | Polish Forces | 19th January 1943 |

Aircraftwoman Godkin and Marine Mietlinski both died in Winsley Hospital. The graves of Aircraftwoman Godkin and Corporal Pocock are listed on the CWGC (Commonwealth War Graves Commission) website. Images of all three headstone can be seen in the St. Nicholas Churchyard Gallery.
