Winterbourne Stoke

1894

Christopher Mitchell, a little boy of this village, had his right foot crushed in a cart wheel yesterday (Thursday) evening, and was conveyed to the Salisbury Infirmary. **Salisbury Times, Friday, 29 June 1894**

1905

Accident through a motor car. Frank Grant, carrier, of Winterbourne Stoke, was admitted into the Salisbury Infirmary on Saturday suffering from injuries to his ankle. He was driving to Shrewton when a motor car frightened the horse, overturned the cart and threw out Mr. Grant and his nephew. The young man was unhurt, but Grant was badly injured. **Salisbury Times, Friday, 12 May 1905**
