This is the last Will and Testament of me Jane Chalke of Winterbourne Stoke in the County of Wilts Widow I give and bequeath to my Sister Elizabeth the wife of Edward Poulton the clear sum of four shillings weekly for and during the term of her natural life to be issuing and payable out of all and singular my residuary Estate and Effects hereinafter mentioned on Monday in each and every week and the first payment to be made on the Monday next after my decease and it is my Will and I hereby direct that such weekly payments shall be made to my said Sister for her own sole and separate use and shall not be subject to the debts control or intermeddling of her present or any future husband and that her own receipt notwithstanding Coverture shall be the only proper discharge for the same I give and bequeath to my Nephew William Poulton the sum of one hundred pounds the same to be paid to him in twelve months next after my decease I give and bequeath to my late Husband's Relations George Gilbert Charles Gilbert & Elias Pretty the sum of ten pounds each the same to be paid to them respectively in one month next after my decease And as to all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my money and securities for money stock in the public funds and all and singular other my Estate whatsoever and

wheresoever subject to the Payment of my just debts and funeral and Testamentary expences and also subject to and charged and chargeable with the Payment of the aforesaid weekly sum of four shillings to my said Sister and the several legacies of one hundred pounds to my said Nephew and ten pounds to each of the said George Gilbert Charles Gilbert & Elias Pretty as aforesaid I give and bequeath the same unto my Brother William Richards to and for his own proper use and benefit And I make nominate constitute and appoint my said Brother William Richards sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of february one thousand eight hundred and thirty *Jane Chalke*
