County Petty Sessions The Middle Winterslow Club Charles Judd and John Hatfield were summoned for damaging a door belonging to David Hobbs, at Winterslow, in removing a cash-box belonging to the Middle Winterslow Friendly Society. The case, which had been adjourned from last week, was eventually dismissed, each party being ordered to pay their own costs. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 12 May 1860**

1875
