my Body I will to the Earth to be buried in Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter named And as touching my Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I give devise and dispose thereof as followeth ffirst I give and devise to George Bowditch Nephew to the Reverend George Bowditch Clerk the Sum of Twenty Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain to be paid to him in a Year after my Decease And his Uncle's or Guardian's Receipt shall be a sufficient Dicharge for the same I give and devise to Carder the Wife of John Reeves of West Winterslow the Sum of five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I give and devise to Joan the wife of Thomas Marsh of West Teverly the Sum of five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I give and devise to Lydia Watkins the wife of Edward Watkins of Middle Winterslow the Sum of five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I give and devise to Deborah Sansbury of ffarely the Sum of five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I give and devise to my Brother Joseph Cratisk the Sum of five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I give and devise to all the Children of my said Brother Joseph Cratisk one shilling each Item I give and devise to Abraham Smith Grandson of my Sister Mary the Sum of ten Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain Item I nominate constitute and appoint my Nephew and my Niece John Smith and Mary Smith joint Executors of this my last Will and Testament unto whom I give full power and Authority to ask for and receive all Money Goods and Chattels that is mine or of right to me belonging and the same to use in paying my ffuneral Charges and Debts and those Legacys as I have above hereby devised and the Residue to and for their own proper use and behoof And I will that they shall divide it equally between them Lastly I will and devise that my said Nephew John Smith who is one of my Executors shall have all my Wearing Apparel Linnen and Woolen for his own use In Witness whereof I Abraham Jackman the Testator have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this fourteenth day of October in the Twentiyeth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain ffrance and Ireland King Defender of the ffaith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and forty six \_ Abraham Jackman his mark \_ sealed and delivered in the presence of *Thomas Sopp* \_ *Mary Robines* \_ *No: Collis*
