1857

Died On the 21st ult., at St. Kilda, of dysentery, Joseph Henry, infant son of Joseph and Susana Mapson, late of Wootton Bassett, Wiltshire England, aged sixteen months. The Argus (Melbourne, Victoria, Australia), Thursday, 15 October 1857
