The photograph above was kindly sent to me by Richard Bailey who restored the image and then set out on a mission to name the children pictured. Although the names were familiar having left the village not long after the photo was taken I couldn't name many of them. The photograph shows children of all ages so its not surprising that many names alluded me. Of course the children were educated separately within the school the infants by Miss Mundy and the older children by Mr. Hayter. The fact too that the village was divided into what I call 4 segments would have meant that not all children would socialise with each other. The four areas being Sandleaze, The main village of Worton, The lower village of Worton (Mill Road) and then the village of Marston that shared the school.
