

Seven children Mary Anne Katherine Jane Thomas Elinor and Susanna Hudden the sum of twenty pounds apiece and that he did make Katherine his wife full and sole Executrix of this his last Will and Testament Nuncupative All with words or the like in and to the same effect he spake and declared in the presence and hearing of William Minty Robert Oram and shortly after Gods Witness our hands and mark Robert Oram the mark of William Minty
