

Tithe Commission Notice Wroughton 1846

The Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales hereby give Notice, that a Copy of the Draft of Apportionment of the Rent Charge agreed to be paid in lie of Tithes, in the District of the Tithings of Elcombe, Westlecott, Salthrop, and Overton, in the parish of *Wroughton* otherwise *Ellingdon*, in the county of Wilts, has been deposited at the house of MR RICHARD STRATTON, at Salthrop, in the said district, for the inspection of all persons interested in the Lands or Tithes of the said district.

And the Commissioners further give Notice, that, pursuant to the Act for the Commutation of Tithes, a Meeting will be holden for the purpose of hearing any objections to the intended Apportionment, by any persons interested as aforesaid; and that such Meeting, will be held at the GODDARD ARMS INN, at Swindon, in the said county, on Saturday the 19th day of September, 1846, at ten o'clock in the forenoon.
