**PURBRICK, HAROLD DESMOND** - Sergeant/Air Gunner 1836889 – Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve - Died 26th April 1944 - Age 19 - Son of Albert Edward and Ellen Rose Purbrick of Yatton Keynell - Buried in Yatton Keynell (St. Margaret's) Churchyard, Yatton Keynell - Grave/Memorial Reference:- South West Corner - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour Plaque in St. Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.

**VAUGHAN, HERBERT SAMUEL** - Lance Bombardier 14387536 - 165 H. A. A. Regiment, Royal Artillery - Died 28th September 1944 - Age 29 - Born in Monmouthshire; Son of Henry Samuel and Mary Cecelia Vaughan; Husband of Nellie Cavell Vaughan of Yatton Keynell - Buried at Jonkerbos War Cemetery, Gelderland, Netherlands - Grave/Memorial Reference:- 7. A. 6. - Headstone inscription reads:- "A Beautiful Memory, Is All That Is Left, Of One We Love, And Never Forget."

**WHITE, WILLIAM JOHN** - Lance Corporal 5722077 - 44 Divisional Provost Company, Corps of Military Police - Died 4th July 1944 - Age 38 - Son of Stephen & Nellie White; Husband of Elsie May White of Yatton Keynell Buried at Bayeux War Cemetery, Normandy, France - Grave/Memorial reference XII. E. 1 - Commemorated on the Roll of Honour Plaque in St. Margaret's Church, Yatton Keynell.
