



CORONERS INQUESTS



Zeals 1800-1899

An inquest was held by Mr. Cardell, deputy coroner, at Zeals, on Wednesday, on the body of an infant two weeks old, named Hugh Carter, who died rather suddenly on the 5th inst. The mother of the deceased died a few days previously, but the child appeared to be in good health with the exception of a slight attack of diarrhoea. Mr. Marshall attended both mother and child, but did not send any medicine for the latter, as he was not requested to do so. From the appearance of the body after death, he was of opinion that death was caused by exhaustive diarrhoea. Verdict accordingly. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 10 October 1868**
