Earle	Richard	<p>Near this Place lye  The Bodies of  RICHARD EARLE  late of this Parish Gent  Who Departed this life,  the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Novem, 1718.  In the 78<sup>th</sup> year of his Age  And also of ANNE his Wife Daughter of JOHN SHEPPARD  of Lansdown in the County of Somerset  Likewise of ANNE their Daughter  Who Departed this life April 28<sup>th</sup> 1724.  In the 48<sup>th</sup> year of her Age  Also Several of their Children  and of the Family of the Earles are here interr'd.  This stone was erected by JOHN EARLE  (Second Son of RICHARD and ANNE EARLE  above said) To the Memory of his Family, Ano. 1728  Likewise in Memory of JOH EARLE Senr.,  Who Died January 23<sup>rd</sup> 1741, Aged 61 Years.  Also in Memory of ELISABETH wife of JOHN EARLE  Who Died May 26, 1744, Aged 55 Years.  And Also in Memory of FRANCES EARLE  Who died May 6, 1753, Aged 71 Years.</p>

Keddle	Ann	<p style="text-align: center;">This tablet is erected by  SAMUEL SHERING KEDDLE, M.D. of Bridport, Dorset,  In memory of his beloved Wife  ANN KEDDLE, youngest Daughter of the late THOMAS BISSEY Esqre.  of Staverton, in this County.  She died after a very protracted illness  11<sup>th</sup> August 1843. Aged 44.  and is interred at Netherbury in the County of Dorset,  constant in her friendships  She was exemplary as a Mother, affectionate as a Wife  and a s a Christian humble and sincere.  Also of her sister  SARAH, Wife of JOHN CHAPMAN KEDDLE Esqre.  of Pickwick, in the Parish of Corsham, in this County  and only other child of the above THOMAS BISSEY  She died 3rdb February 1838. Aged 42.  and also of his Brother  the above JOHN CHAPMAN KEDDLE,  eldest Son of JOHN KEDDLE Esqre. of Hatchlands  in the Parish of Netherbury, Dorset.  He died without issue 11<sup>th</sup> April 1843.  Aged 57.  and with his Wife is interred in a vault in this Chapel.</p>

A Master of the Bench of Lincolns Inn  and Recorder of Doncaster  Born 25<sup>th</sup> March 1843 – Died 23<sup>rd</sup> Decr. 1915  Buried at Holt</p>

Pilley	Absalom	<p style="text-align: center;">In  Loving memory of  <b>ABSALOM PILLEY</b>  Born June 14: 1857. Died June 3, 1894  who was for 16 years Master of  Holt National School  This tablet is erected by  the teachers, scholars and other friends  “The memory of the just is blessed.”</p>
Power	Francis	<p style="text-align: center;">Near this place  are deposited the Remains of  <b>FRANCIS POWER</b>  (of Kenilworth in the County of Warwick)  (and of the City of Bath)  who departed this Life  the 11<sup>th</sup> of May 1781  Aged 53 years.  Also in Memory  of his two Sons  <b>ANTHONY FLETCHER POWER</b>  who died in New Orleans  and <b>FRANCES THOMAS ROBINS POWER</b>  who died in the Island of Jamaica.  <b>ANN</b> Wife and Mother of the above,  died the 27 of April 1832,  Aged 82 years and 10 months.  With grateful recollections of parental  and fraternal affection, this tablet is  inscribed by the surviving Daughters,  <b>ANN</b> and <b>ELIZABETH</b></p>

JOHN BURTON WATKIN, A.M. late of Lockeridge House in this County Vicar of Marshfield, Gloucestershire and Lord of the Manor of this Parish who Died March 20<sup>th</sup> 1822 in the 77<sup>th</sup> Year of his Age. BARBARA, his beloved Wife has erected This Monument. Also to the Memory of BARBARA, his Wife Daughter of the Revd. EDWARD HERVEY of Hulcote, Bedfordshire who died at Lockeridge House, 6<sup>th</sup> Decr. 1837. Aged 83.</p>
